11.00 am - Review of agenda and welcome to Transnational Meeting

11.05 am - Welcome of new member

PM introduces Miguel David Guevara Espinar, psychologist and lecturer in the School of Psychology at University of Salamanca. His role in the project will be pioneering in the approach to how migrants and state manage issues related to mental health, inclusive policies and practices of gender equality. His clinical experience with patients in his daily practice will be a great asset to plan qualitative and quantitative measures in relation to impact of the activities of dissemination.

11.10am - Report on completed products (Syllabus), hosting of the Multiplier Event and the Teaching and Training Activity

PM reports on the completion of the Syllabus (Film Analysis) and the celebration of the Multiplier Event hosted in Nottingham (joint venture between Nottingham Trent University and Broadway Cinemas) and the Teaching and Training Activity hosted at Uppsala University.

Dr Jesús Benito, as web master of the web page, details the uploading and lay-out of the syllabus of the key-study films. He informs about the new structure of contents and information of the web. The changes in the menu and the presentation of information have been carried out after having presented the project to different audiences and different places (seminars and various screenings in Graz, Nottingham, Salamanca and Valladolid). Dr Benito invites members to contribute with articles, pieces of news, seminars or any other work members are carrying out in connection with the project. PM specifies the importance of planning activities that prove the impact that the use and consumption intellectual products of the Project have upon various audiences and venues.

PM talks about the success of the Multiplier Event celebrated in Nottingham on April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The Multiplier Event was entitled “Migration and Hospitality in European Cinema” and was celebrated in Broadway Cinema (Nottingham, UK). Dr Martin O’Shaughnessy, Professor of Film Studies at Nottingham Trent and director of the Multiplier Event, informed about the one-day and the interaction among general public, representative from local and international NGOs, two film directors and different communities in Nottingham. New possibilities for further collaboration are being explored in terms of responses gathered in the quality evaluations about the transformative quality of the intellectual products of the projects.

Dr Markus Heide, convenor of the Teaching and Training Event “Seminar on Hospitality in Movies” that took place at the University of Uppsala (Sweden) between May 27<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019 detailed the ideas, lectures, discussions, screenings, Q&As and interaction among audiences of different ages, origins and educational profiles of the Event. Dr Heide organized the event under the slogan “we learn from you and you learn from us”. This planning guaranteed the dissemination of project materials and enhanced the establishment of fields of academic cooperation among students at partner universities, one of the main goals the Teaching and Training activity set for itself.

12.05pm - Progress of Music Documentary Film

PM talks about the Documentary on migrant musicians in Europe and the positive reactions received after a miscellaneous audience watched the clips shown during the Teaching and Training Event at Uppsala (May 2019). She clarifies the suitability of deadlines in relation to the processes of final editing that are required before its release in Spring 2020 at the Multiplier Event to be hosted at University of Salamanca (Spain).

12.15pm - Planning for Fall 2019 meeting in Madrid

Dr Cristina Garrigós (UNED, Spain) explores suitable dates for the third transnational meeting of project members scheduled for Fall 2019. She informs about the parallel

program that will be organized to gather the members of the team in a screening of a Spanish documentary on the subject of Migration and a Q&A with its director. The activity will be open to the general public so that the team can engage in the transformative possibilities of sharing the screening with the general public. The project members agree on October 24th as a suitable date for the projection and October 25<sup>th</sup> for the transnational meeting so that there is time to reflect and analyze the quality and feedback forms.

Dr Garrigós announces that these two days could also be used for the tentative recording of Podcasts on issues of Hospitality and European Film as potential teaching tools that would be uploaded on the UNED network. Project members highlight the adequacy of the proposal to maximize time and economic resources. PM congratulates Dr Garrigós for the national and international impact that these podcasts may have in the future.

12.30pm- Salamanca Hospitality Conference Spring 2020, Group Meeting and Multiplier Events (MOOC and Documentary)

PM details the agenda, contents and prospective participants in the Multiplier Event 2 to be organized at University of Salamanca in Spring 2020. Project members agree on the suitability of making it coincide with UN Refugee Week organized around the UN Refugee Day celebrated on June 20<sup>th</sup>. Apart from serving as Multiplier Events for the MOOC and the Documentary, there will be parallel activities including a micro-fiction literary contest on migration designed to attract international audiences and maximize its impact.

12.45pm - Project Spin offs: Transformative quality of the project and writing of quality evaluations

PM summarizes the main results obtained from quality surveys and feedback forms distributed alongside the different activities organized through and around the Project and its Intellectual Products. She draws attention to the importance of long-term assessment strategies to implement university education, secondary educational system, cooperation and integration within NGOs and other non-profit associations and the project members' skill and the participants.
